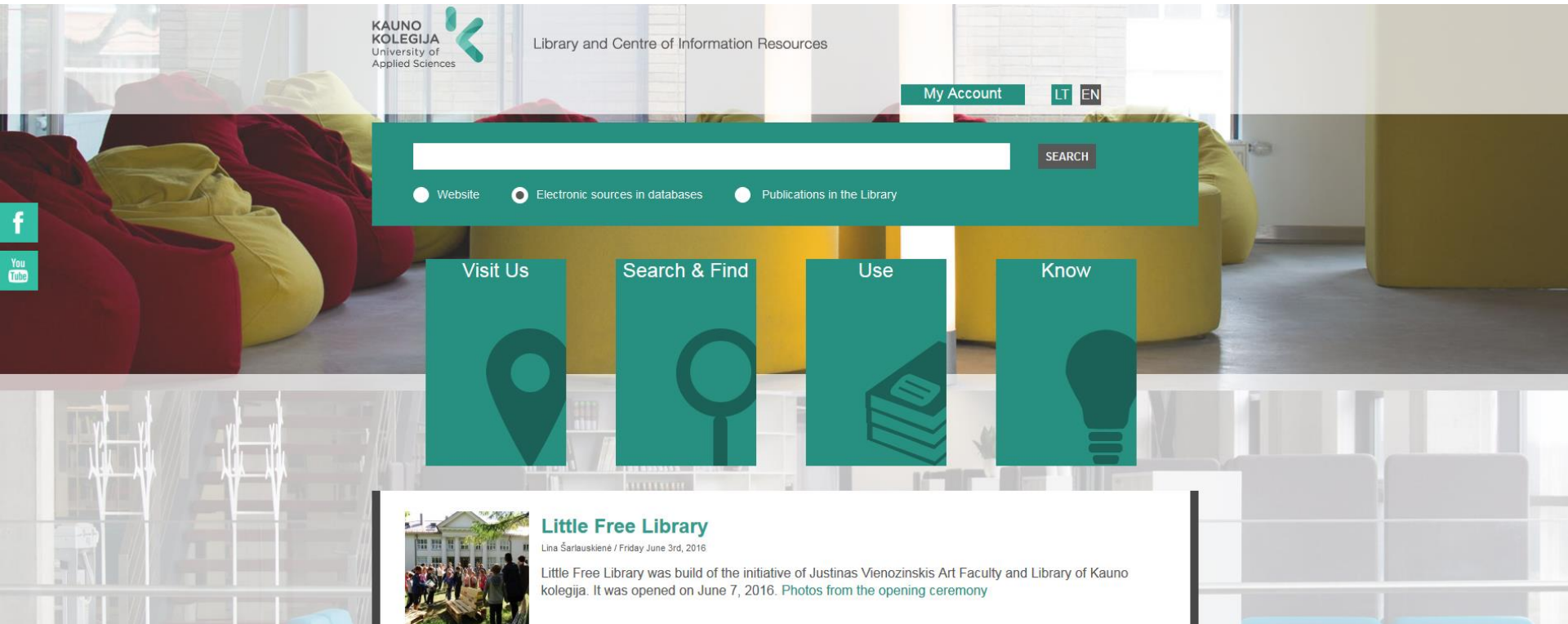


Kauno kolegija / University of Applied Sciences



Kauno kolegija is a state-owned institution providing higher education in the areas of technologies, social sciences, biomedicine, humanities and arts. All together it offers over 50 study programs. More than 7000 students are currently studying and about 600 teachers are currently working here.

Library and Centre of Information Resources



Library is the Kauno kolegija division providing professional information services and access to information resources needed for collegial studies as well as applied research, and offering modern learning environments.



- The Central Library is located in a new and modern building. The official opening took place on 6 November, 2014.
- The Library is located on three floors. The area of the Library is about 2160 square meters. There are 2328 meters of shelves for books, 234 places for readers, 25 computers for readers.





- The funds of the Library include about 128000 items and 32000 titles of publications. There are 65000 items and 15000 titles of publications in Central Library.
- The book funds on the shelves are arranged according to UDC and author's mark.
- The Library uses the ALEPH Library System, which is connected to the RFID security equipment.
- All of the publications of the open funds are included into the e-catalogue and have RFID tags.
