

Kauno kolegija subscribed databases for 2026

All subscription resources can be used by every student or employee of the college while at the college, at home or anywhere else.

If you are not at the college and want to use the databases, you must log in to the [Virtual Library](#) or the website db.kaunokolegija.lt with the e-mail address provided to you by the college starting with @ and a password.

Sources from subscribed databases can be found by searching in one place ([Virtual Library](#)) or by opening each database separately (database addresses can be found on the website <http://db.kaunokolegija.lt/>). In some cases, it is necessary or worthwhile to open separate databases, because certain information will not be available in the virtual library. For example, only the *Passport* database can be used to open statistical and analytical information, only *O'Reilly* can you find videos, audio books, interactive courses and expert playlists, EBSCO and *O'Reilly* platforms have AI assistants for search.

International databases available for subscription

- **EBSCO eBook Academic Collection** and **EBSCO Publishing** databases contain more than 332 thousand sources in various fields (19629 scientific journals, 267583 e-books, 45321 other sources). 5792 scientific journals from EBSCO Publishing databases are included in the CA *Web of Science* database and 8106 – in the *Scopus* database. Searching in these databases is facilitated by an AI assistant, which helps to find relevant articles faster, summarize content and refine search queries. The sources of this database can be read and also listened to.

- **O'Reilly for Higher Education** is an extremely valuable database in the fields of technology, informatics and data analysis, but you can find the latest information on various innovative topics. Special attention is paid to the topic of artificial intelligence in various fields. The database contains over 50 thousand e-books, 5 thousand interactive courses, 2 thousand videos, 3 thousand audio books, 31 thousand expert playlists. The database's AI assistant facilitates the search for relevant information.
How to use it? E-books can be found in the [Virtual Library](#), and all sources and the AI assistant can only be found by opening the database at <https://www.oreilly.com/library-access/>. Once opened, you need to find the name of your institution (Kauno kolegija) in the list and log in with your Kauno kolegija email address and password.
- **Springer Journals** is an international database of scientific journals, which provides access to 2178 peer-reviewed scientific journals covering topics in the natural, technological, medical and social sciences. The database is convenient for searching for peer-reviewed scientific articles and is characterized by high quality of publications. 1879 journals in this database are included in the *Web of Science* database and 1873 in *Scopus*.

- **Taylor & Francis** is a database relevant to representatives of the humanities and social sciences, where you can find about 2000 scientific e-journals. The database provides an opportunity to conveniently search for information and use peer-reviewed scientific sources in humanities and social sciences studies and research. 1687 journals in this database are included in the *Web of Science* database and 1898 in the *Scopus* database.

- **Emerald Management** is a database dedicated to management, business, economics and organizational research, which contains 172 scientific journals. Publications are focused on applied research and practical solutions. 157 journals in this database are included in the *Web of Science* database and 167 in the *Scopus* database.

- **Passport** – a statistical and analytical database that provides structured information about the countries of the world, their economic, political and social indicators, as well as the largest corporations and organizations, their financial quantitative data. The use of statistical and analytical data in study works, when preparing analyses, presentations or assignments, especially when performing comparative analyses, is extremely valuable.

- **Vilnius Gediminas Technical University (VGTU) e-book collection** is intended for studies of technology, engineering, business, management, communication and other sciences.

How to use? E-books can be found by searching in the [Virtual Library](#) or by opening the database at <https://ebooks-vilniustech-lt.db.kaunokolegija.lt/my-library>

- **Kaunas University of Technology (KTU) e-book collection** includes e-books in various fields of study, especially for studies in technology, engineering, computer science, natural sciences, business and other fields.

- **Lithuanian Standardization Department (LST) standards** – over 56000 constantly updated e-standards collection, digital access to which is provided for study and research purposes through the eLABa consortium. A standard is an agreed set of rules, requirements or norms that define how a product should be manufactured, a service provided or a process performed.

How to use? Standards can be found and opened only by logging in to the [Virtual Library](#) with your college email address starting with @ and a password.
